Have you, at any time in the past 3 years, **fished to feed your family**, either by dip netting, pole fishing, or by working in the commercial fishing industry.

AND You fished/worked 20 or more miles from home 7 different nights (does not need to be consecutive)?

OR did you **work logging, farming**, or did you **pick berries** outside of the Mat-Su Borough.

AND did your **children go with you or** another person 14 yrs or older while doing any of the above activities. **Or**, did your child actively participate by him/herself?

If the answer is **yes**, your family may qualify for Migrant Ed Services.
